

Our Lady of Perpetual Help Service Encounter Guide

- Each candidate for confirmation will practice the Spiritual Works of Mercy (pray for the living and the dead-Adoration, Rosary, Stations, Divine Mercy, Altar Serving, Choir/Handbells)
- (10 Hours) and participate with their family in the Corporal Works of Mercy (Some examples include to Feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, clothe, food-clothes drive for homeless, help at soup kitchen, greeting cards for the seniors, hospitalized or for the prison ministry) (5 Hours).
 - We also want to encourage students to do at least 50% of their service hours at Our Lady parish.
- Confirmation Year 1 (7th Grade) requirement is a minimum of 15 hours by May 24th 2024.
- Confirmation Year 2 (8th Grade) requirement is a minimum of 15 hours by Mar 24th 2024.
- Candidates for Confirmation must have a minimum of 30 hours: 15 hours
 (Year 1) and 15 hours of (Year 2) of service hours by Mar 24th.

Step 1: Register

- Go to X2vol.com
- Click Join
- Click Complete Registration on the Left Hand Side
- Find Your School: Type Our Lady of Perpetual Help and click Search
- Account Lookup: Enter your last name and email address and click search
- Check to make sure Student Registration is complete: First name, Last Name, email address, DOB, Student ID
- Create a password and confirm same password
- Select the group for your grade
- Check the two boxes
- Select if 13 and above or the other option depending on your age
- Select Complete Registration

Step 2: Logging Hours

- Go to X2vol.com
- Click Log in
- Click continue with Google
- Click on Opportunities and Projects tab
- Click on My Activity Log
- Click Create New under personal project
- Type in the name of organization
- Next Box fill out a brief description of what you did
- Don't click the recurring button
- Click the field of interest: Faith Based...
- Type in the Name of the Activity Contact (VBS-Jisha Thomas)
- Do Not put a phone number ONLY Name and Email
- Date of service please add the first date if consecutive multiple days are served
- Type Total number of hours served
- Type a brief reflection-What you learned? How did this service make you grow in your faith?
- Choose the goal you would like the hours to be applied to
- Click the Oath
- Click Submit
- Claim Successfully Submitted message should pop up
- Your hours will then be verified by the activity Contact and approved by the approval contact.
